#### VII. Coaches Report

- Chocolate milk for the players after lifts assists with their recovery by providing the right balance of
  carbohydrates, amino acids, and protein. The quicker the players start the rebuilding process while
  waiting for parents, fills in the gap until they are able to eat when they get home.
  - It costs \$54.00 a week to continue the program with a total cost of approximately \$1600.00 \$1700.00.
  - Jessica Schroek motioned to continue the chocolate milk program for the players and Beth Gardner seconded the motion.
- There are T-shirt days on lift days. Currently, they are tank top Tuesdays. Coaches would like to
  incorporate next year's theme for Monday and Thursday lifts. The shirts will not only project a
  professional and organized appearance but will also add elements of teamwork and pride.
  - The cost for 180 shirts is \$1600.00.
  - Beth Gardner motioned to approve the \$1600.00 for t-shirts for the players and Jessica Schroek seconded the motion.
- There are upcoming clinics for coaches. The cost for the playbook clinic is \$1000.00 for the entire coaching staff. There's one session in January and February. There's an additional annual three to four day training which provides access to online videos and forms for \$499/each.
