August 8th, 2022 – USC Community & Recreation Center

I. CALL TO ORDER AND GREETING

Vice President Conrad Howe called the meeting to order at 7:31 PM. There were 30 members in attendance.

OLD BUSINESS

All proceeds benefit our student athletes. Parking will continue to be in the Theater entrance parking lot set back from the front of the High School.

- Considerations are being finalized for our 2022 Media Services provider. Board members met with Vizion on July 15th to discuss pricing as well as our needs. The boosters will be going with a combination of services from Vizion as well as Story of the Season. M&M Photography will be taking the pictures for the Game Day Program at picture day this Friday.
